This is a friendly reminder that the 2026 ATLAS Symposium registration is now open.

The ATLAS Symposium is an annual event that allows students to present their research and learn about ongoing projects within the department. Faculty members, postdoctoral researchers and staff are invited to attend.

This year's symposium will take place from Wednesday 8th to Friday 10th April 2026. The three-day event will feature four major components:

- A series of scientific presentations by graduate students. This component will allow graduate students to complete their public presentation requirement while sharing their research with the department;
- A poster session generally showcasing undergraduate student research;
- Talks from 3 keynote speakers from the industry or academia;
- A banquet at the Faculty Club, providing students with the opportunity to interact with professionals from industry and academia (Friday, April 10th 2026).

This year we welcome both undergraduate and graduate students to participate in Poster Presentations and Oral Presentations, with the following priorities:

- Poster Presentations: Priority will be given to the undergraduate students.
- Oral Presentations: Priority will be given to the graduate students.

The ATLAS symposium has become a tradition in our department, and you are strongly encouraged to participate. To register, please fill out the [registration form](#) by **February 27th 2026**.

Simultaneously, **we are also opening abstract submission**. Please submit your abstract as a word document to me and Baptiste via email at vrosa@ualberta.ca and/or bcoutret@ualberta.ca.

The abstract must have:

- Concise title;
- Co-authors list and affiliations;
- Font Times New Roman 12, single spaced;
- Maximum 300 words;
- No references.
